Clean Slate Program

The Clean Slate Program will provide gainful employment as well as skill development to aid employees in their journey from homeless to home.

The Clean Slate program was founded on the belief that everyone is worthy and able to be employed.

Clean Slate Employees

All Clean Slate employees are hired after passing a drug screen and background check. Each employee then receives both job and soft skill training before starting their shift assignment. Additionally, every employee has weekly one-on-one supervision with their manager.

Clean Slate provides all employees with uniforms, housing support, and transportation to and from work. Full benefits are offered to those working 30+ hours per week.

Clean Slate Staffing

Our temporary to permanent staffing program moves qualified candidates to jobs within the hotel industry in less than 90 days. This program allows hotels to utilize the Clean Slate staffing service and hire new hotel employees from our temp staff.

Clean Slate will tailor the length of the program and training for every hotel location based on manager feedback. Our goal is to provide hotels with reliable, trained, and fully vetted job candidates to reduce employee turnover and speed up the onboarding process.

Clean Slate will provide every hotel staff supervisor with an on-call manager who will be available for site visits. The managers will ensure that we get the right candidates through the door. If a temp worker is not a fit for the team, the manager will schedule a new employee as soon as possible.

Social Enterprise
